The meeting commenced with the University Kulgeet. At the outset, Dr. I. B. Maurya, Director of Education, AU Kota warmly welcomed all members of the Academic Council, including distinguished external members: Dr. R. K. Rai, former Professor and Head, Division of Agronomy, IARI, New Delhi; Dr. Praveen Singh, former Vice-Chancellor, SKNAU, Jobner; Dr. Meghendra Sharma, Pro Vice-Chancellor, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj University, Navi Mumbai; and Prof. B. K. Sharma, former Director of Education, SKNAU, Jobner. He also welcomed all Deans, Directors, the Registrar, Comptroller, and senior university officials.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and Chairman extended a formal welcome to the external members by presenting bouquets. The meeting primarily focused on agenda items related to the upcoming 8<sup>th</sup> Convocation, scheduled for 19<sup>th</sup> May 2025, along with various academic proposals.

In his opening remarks, the Vice-Chancellor expressed satisfaction with the university's achievements in academics, research, extension and HRD. He highlighted recent initiatives including Kulpati-Vidyarthi Samvad, a new training policy, infrastructure upgrades, farm mechanization, enhanced transportation facilities, and incentives for quality research publications and project proposals. He emphasized that these initiatives are instrumental in positioning the university among the leading agricultural institutions in the country. He also called upon senior officials to ensure the successful organization of the 8<sup>th</sup> Convocation.

The esteemed external members namely Dr. R. K. Rai, Dr. Praveen Singh, Dr. Meghendra Sharma and Prof. B. K. Sharma commended the university's rapid progress over the past two years. They acknowledged significant strides in academic and administrative performance, student achievements and placements, research output, and infrastructure development. The members encouraged the university faculty to work with unity, a positive outlook, and a strong sense of ownership to further elevate the institution's growth and reputation.




At the outset, the Member Secretary welcomed Chairman and all the members of the committee and presented the agenda of the meeting in brief.

After thorough discussion and based on the UGC Guidelines- 2018, Acts and Statutes of the University, Recommendations of the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC, the following recommendations were made-

#### A. Score cards for Direct Recruitment on Teaching Cadre posts including SMS in the KVKs

- Scorecards should be simple, well explained and clear. It should ensure screening of real talent based on merit.
- For screening of candidates for entry level posts such as Assistant Professor or equivalent and SMS, more weightage shall be given to Academics (marks obtained in UG/PG/ Ph.D./ NET); while for higher cadre posts, such as Associate Prof. / Senior Scientist cum Head and Professor or equivalent, less weightage shall be given to academics while more weightage for professional attainments and achievements.

- Ratio of Marks of scorecard and interview shall be 80:20 for Assistant Professor/ Assistant Librarian or equivalent post and SMS, 75: 25 for Associate Professor/ Senior Scientist cum Head or equivalent post and 70: 30 for Professor or equivalent posts. (Refer clause 4 (i) of chapter 5 of the University Statutes).
- No. of candidates to be called for interview shall be in the ratio of 1.10 (maximum) of the number of posts (subject-/ category- wise) to have more competition.
- The condition of securing 50 % marks separately in interview shall be deleted.
- If the number of applications are more than 100 against each post, the University may conduct written test for shortlisting of candidates in case of entry-level posts only.

The updated score cards for direct recruitment on the post of SMS, Assistant Professor/ Assistant Librarian or equivalent, Associate Professor/ Senior Scientist cum Head or equivalent and Professor/ Chief Scientist or equivalent are attached herewith in Annex. I to IV, respectively.

#### B. Score cards for Personal Promotion of Teachers and Officers (under CAS)

- API and eligibility criteria as per UGC guidelines.
- Scorecards for CAS should be broad and accommodating performance indicators of different spheres of university mandates/ activities.
- More weightage to professional attainments and achievements during assessment period.
- More weightage to quality research publications. No marks shall be allotted for research papers published in journals having NAAS rating below 4.0.
- Marks for revenue generation shall be included in the scorecards
- Marks shall be allotted to trainings attended by candidates during assessment period.
- More weightage to grading of candidate in Annual Self-Appraisal Report.
- Additional weightage shall be given to teachers/ officers working full time in Administrative offices/ COE office/ seed production farms, etc. where they do not get opportunity of teaching/ research/ extension.

The updated score cards for Personal Promotion (under CAS) from Assistant Professor Stage-I to Stage-II, Assistant Professor Stage- II to Stage- III, Assistant Professor Stage- III to Associate Professor and Associate Professor to Professor are attached herewith in Annex. V to VIII, respectively.

**C. Score cards for Best Teacher, Best Research Scientist & Best Extension Educationist Award**


The committee also perused the existing criteria and scorecards for awarding Best teacher/ Best Research Scientist / Best Extension Educationist Awards and suggests the following-

- The nomenclature of 'Best Extension Educationist' award shall be 'Best Extension Scientist' award.
- The qualifying service to become eligible for applying of the awards shall be minimum 8 years.
- There shall not be any restriction on the assessment period for the award. The assessment shall essentially be made over the entire service period spent in the University of the employee applying for the award.
- The committee was of the opinion that the scorecard for each category of Award shall be exclusive for that particular award, and hence the criteria shall be majorly to that particular sphere of work, e.g. the score card for Best Teacher Award shall include majorly the criteria related to teaching (Courses taught, PG students guided, course curricula development, practical/ teaching manual prepared, so on and so forth.) Very less weightage shall be given to other spheres of work.
- There should be significant weightage of students' feedback in scorecard for Best Teacher Award.

The updated score cards for Best Teacher, Best Research Scientist & Best Extension Scientist Award are attached herewith in Annex. IX to XI, respectively

1. **Name of award:** Agriculture University's "Best Teacher Award/ Best Research Scientist Award and Best Extension Scientist Award" for the excellence in the field of teaching, extension & research respectively. The award will carry a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- along with a certificate and a memento.
2. **Presentation of award:** The award will be presented to the selected candidate on the Foundation Day Ceremony (14 September) of the University.
3. **Objective:** To recognize the talented faculty who has shown excellence in the field of Agriculture Education, Research and Extension.
4. **Number and frequency :** The number of awards will be **ONE** in each field ( Education, Research and Extension) every year as per suitability .
5. **Eligibility:** The entire faculty including Professor, Associate Professor/Senior Scientist & Head and Assistant Professor/SMS posted in Teaching/Research / Extension having served the University for a minimum of **eight years**, excluding period spent in study leave/ EOL. The assessment shall be made based on the **entire service period** in the university including probation period. The applicant is expected to be a role model with high moral values and must not have been penalized or any enquiry pending against him/her. For which the controlling officers will submit a certificate along with application form. Persons holding the post of Deans/Directors/COE etc. are not eligible for the award.
6. **Administration of the award:**
  - i. The applications / proposals will be invited by the Director, HRD in the month of August of every year and unit/Officer In-charge will forward only best three based on score to the reviewing officer for onward submission.
  - ii. To evaluate the applications and make recommendation, there shall be a screening committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, AU, Kota.
  - iii. In case of tie (equal score) between two candidates, the candidate having more age/ experience will be given preference.
  - iv. Once awarded, the employee will not be eligible for consideration of the award for next 5 years.
  - v. Award will be given only if the candidate is getting more than 60 % marks in score card.
  - vi. Award may be given to a suitable candidate even if single application is received and fulfil the criteria for the award.
  - vii. All the publications should have been published as on the last date prescribed for submission of application.
7. **Evaluation criteria :** As per attached score card (Annexure-IA/IB/IC)
8. **Procedure:**
  - i. The applicant will fill up application on prescribed format and submit it to respective Unit In-charge and Dean or Director for onward transmission to University.
  - ii. The Dean/Director after having nomination from each College/KVK/Department/Research Centre will forward applications after verifying the information and mentioning the full justification that "How he/she is eligible for this recognition".
  - iii. **The applications should be invited every year by the Director, HRD in the month of August.**

- iv. The applications, complete in all respect should reach to the office of the Director, HRD on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August of every year. Applications received after due date will not be considered in any case.
- v. The decision of the committee will be final and not be reviewable or can not be challenged, RTI, and for legal case (if any) Kota will be the jurisdiction area only.
